<b>Balochistan</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>RRT teams are working for contact tracing</li> </ul>

<b>Risk Communication Message:</b>										
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Clean hands regularly with an alcohol-based hand rub, or wash thoroughly with soap.</li> <li>Clean surfaces regularly with recommended disinfectants (70% Ethyl Alcohol or 0.5% bleach solution).</li> <li>Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth with contaminated hands.</li> <li>Practice respiratory hygiene by coughing or sneezing into a bent elbow or tissue and then immediately dispose off.</li> <li>Wear a medical/surgical mask if you have respiratory symptoms and perform hand hygiene after disposing off of the mask.</li> <li>Maintain a minimum of mandatory two meter distance from individuals with respiratory symptoms.</li> <li>Healthcare workers are required to select and use appropriate PPE.</li> </ul>										
<b>Administrative controls</b>										
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ensure the availability of IPC resources such as PPE, appropriate infrastructure, clear IPC policies, access to lab testing, triage and patient placement, adequate staff and training of the staff.</li> </ul>										
<b>Environmental and engineering controls</b>										
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Stay in ventilated rooms</li> <li>Clean the surfaces with recommended disinfectants.</li> </ul>										
<b>Social Behavior Change:</b>										
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Practice social distancing, particularly from individuals showing respiratory symptoms.</li> <li>Avoid mass gatherings like weddings, cinemas, crowded shopping malls and restaurants.</li> <li>Avoid gathering of more than 10-20 persons.</li> </ul>
