



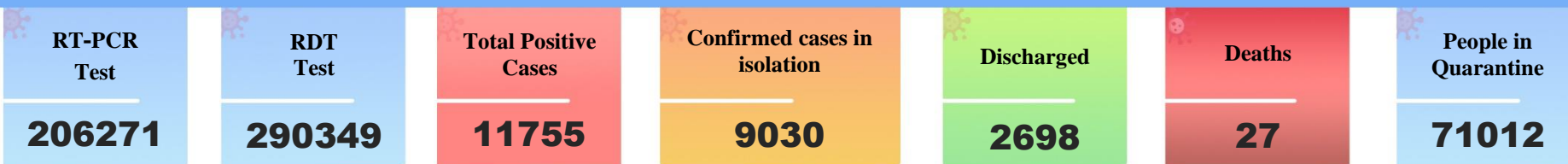

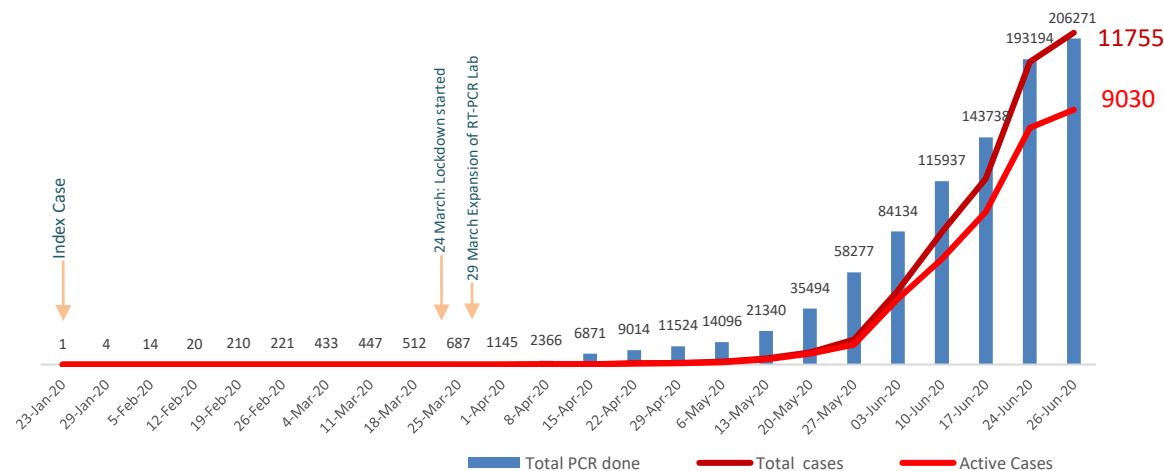

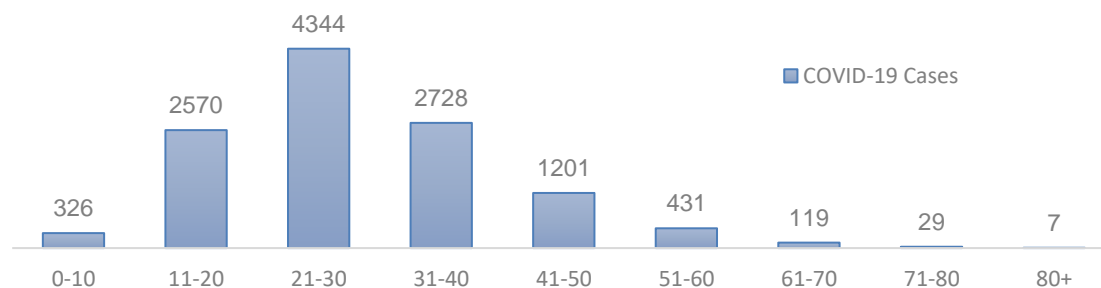
Key Activities:

- The Ministry of Health and Population has published a notice regarding the operation of the COVID-19 RT-PCR testing laboratory. [\(Click here for more information\)](#)

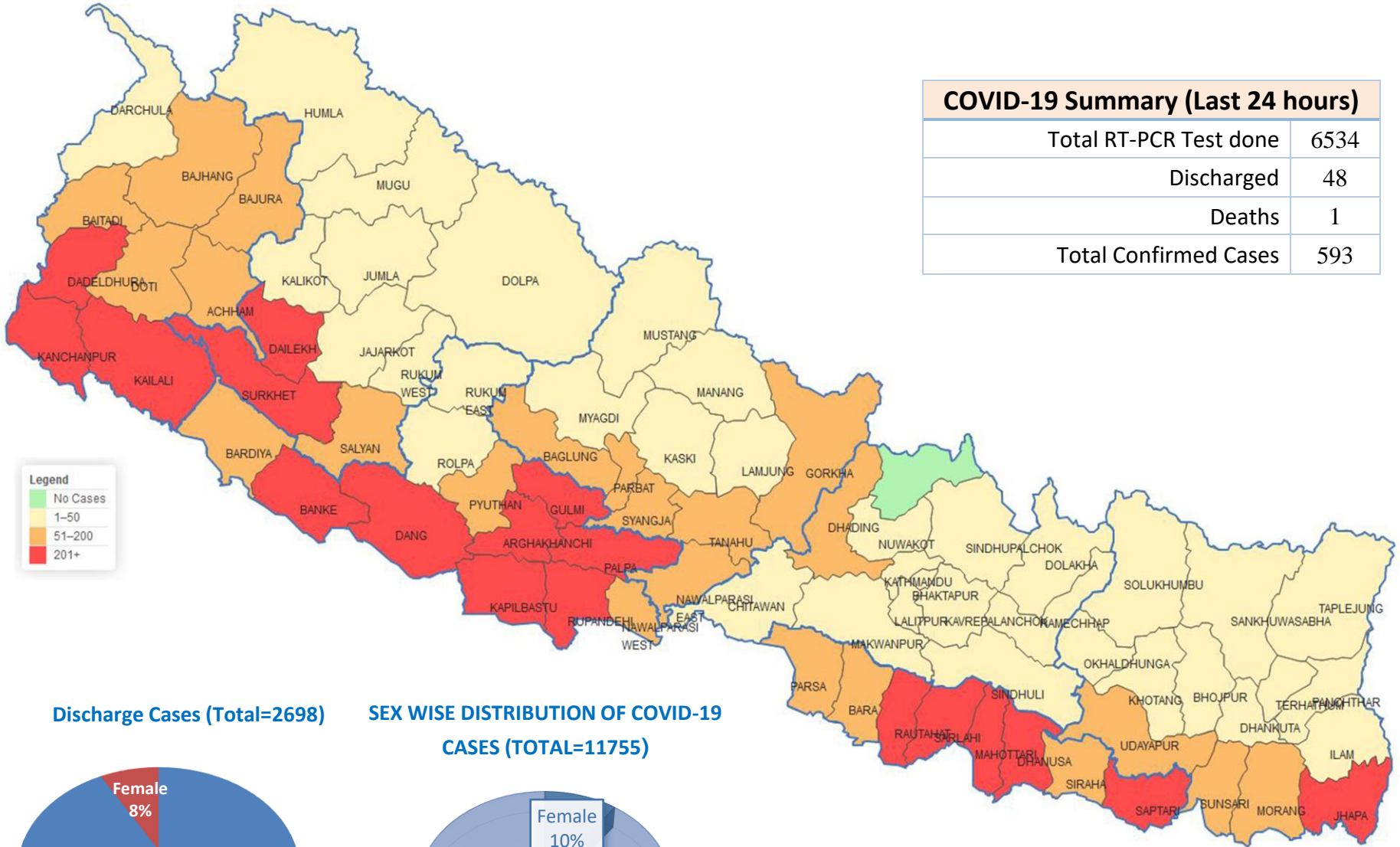
Trend of RT-PCR and COVID-19 cases



Age group wise distribution of COVID-19 Cases



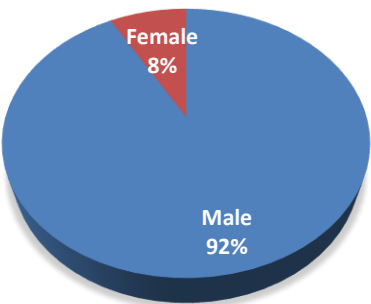
Districts with reported laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases



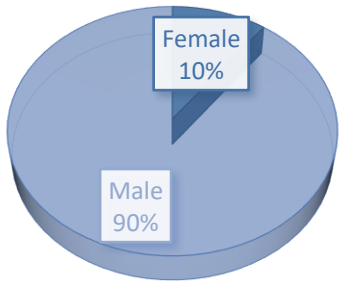

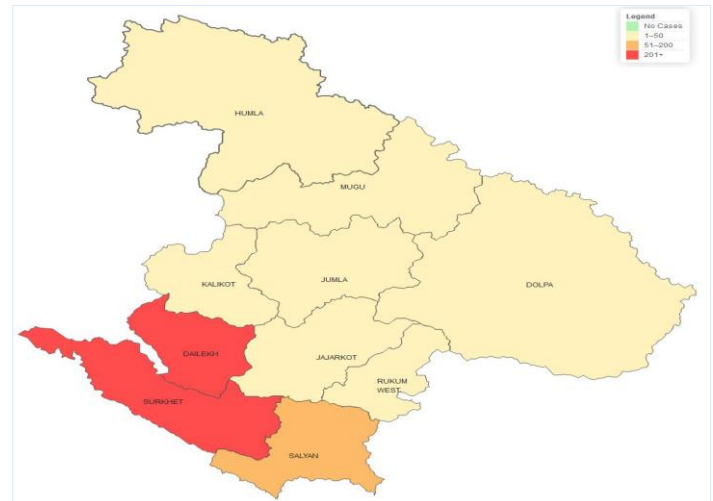

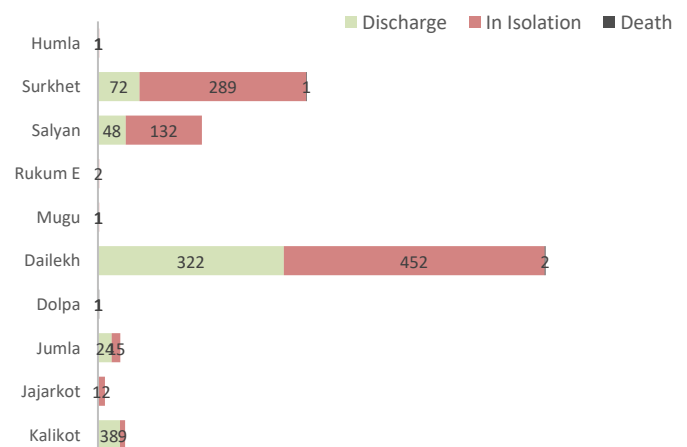
Karnali Province

Key activities

- A RT-PCR machine has been installed at Dailekh Hospital to provide COVID-19 sample testing services.
- Virtual training on Case Investigation and Contact Tracing (CICT) of COVID cases is being provided to provincial CICT team and CICT teams formed at local levels with assistance from experts of other organizations.
- More than 98% of COVID-19 positive cases reported within the province are returnees from India.
- Training on Yoga practices were provided people in quarantine of Karnali Province and Ayurvedic medicines were provided to improve the immunity of people in isolation centers on the occasion of International Day of Yoga.
- As increase in cases of mental illnesses were identified, psychosocial counselling through different IEC materials has been provided to people in quarantine and their family members.
