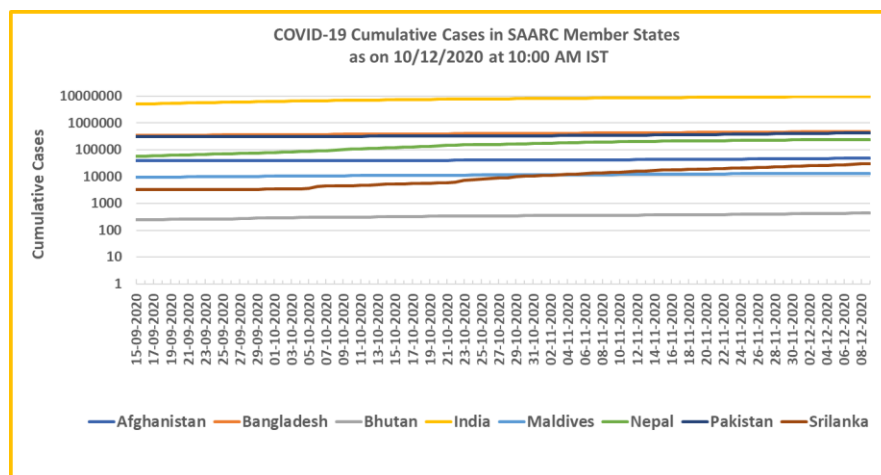
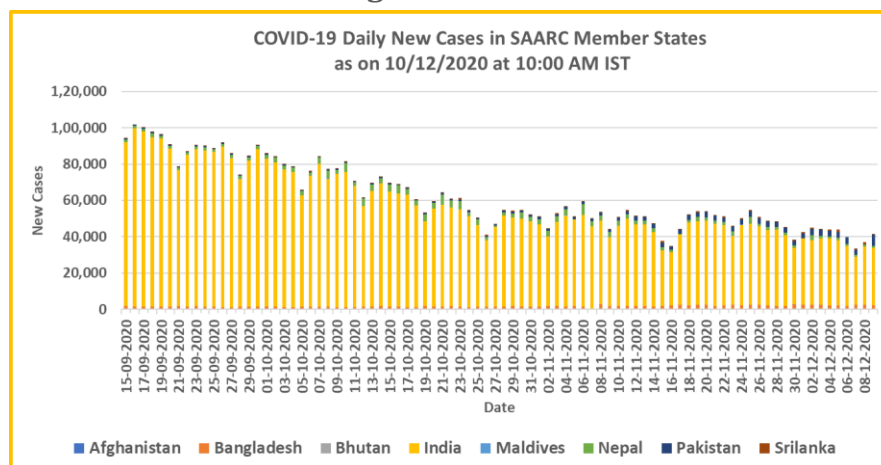

- SAARC region comprises of over 21% of the world's population which remains vulnerable towards COVID-19. The Member States have reported 1,10,17,484 cases, a total of 1,61,068 deaths in the region, and 1,03,36,944 recovered cases.
