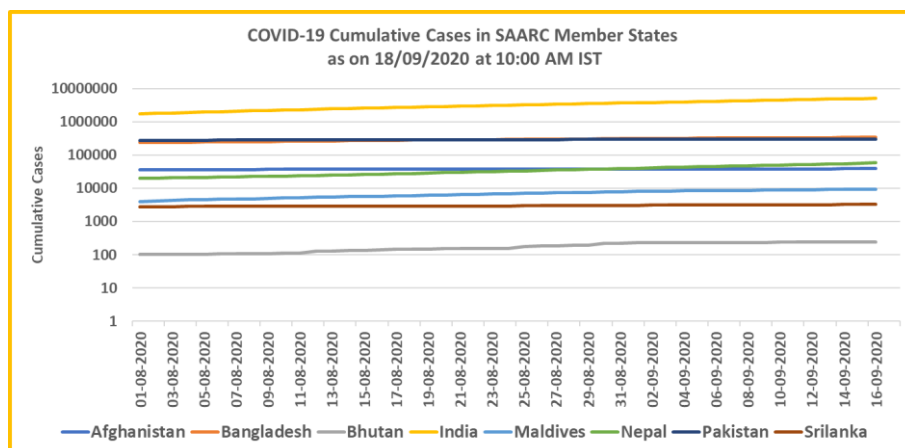
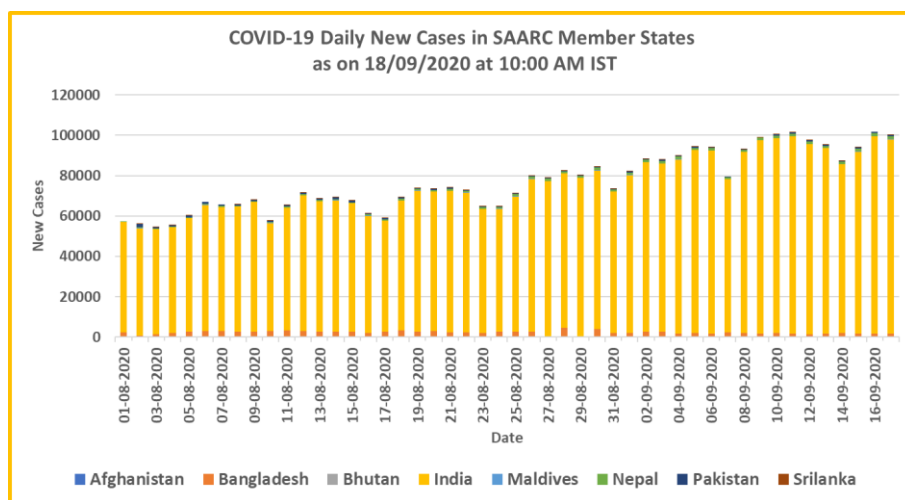

- As of 17<sup>th</sup> September 2020- 29,737,453 people have been affected by COVID-19 worldwide. About 937,391 lives have been lost. (Source: WHO)
