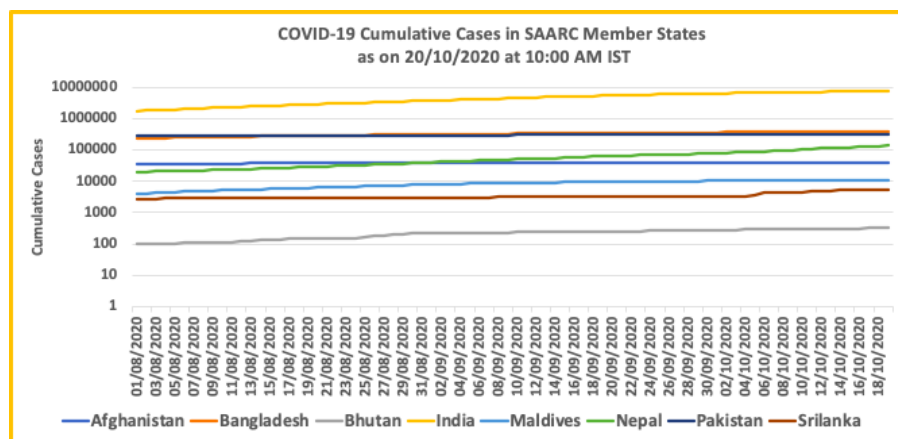
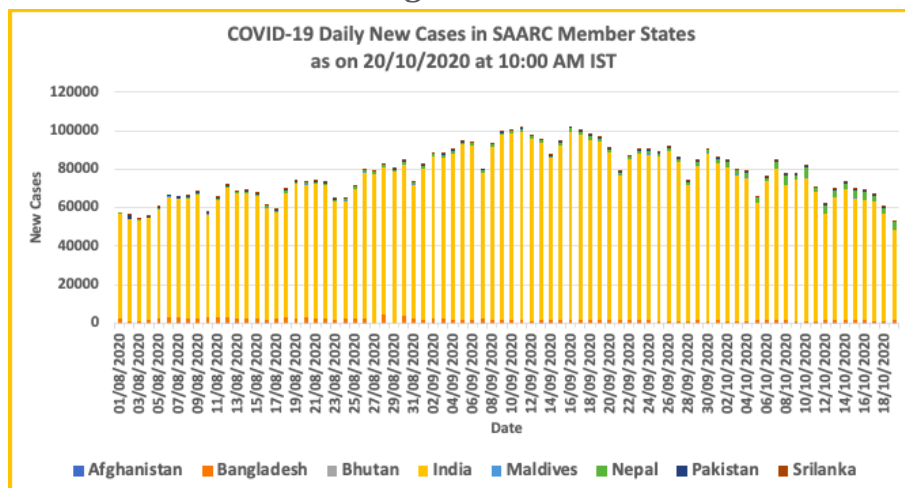

- As of 19th October 2020- 39,944,882 people have been affected by COVID-19 worldwide. About 1,111,998 lives have been lost. (Source: WHO)
- SAARC region comprises of over 21% of the world's population which remains vulnerable towards COVID-19. The Member States have reported 85,04,231 cases, a total of 1,29,841 deaths in the region, and 74,88,538 recovered cases.
