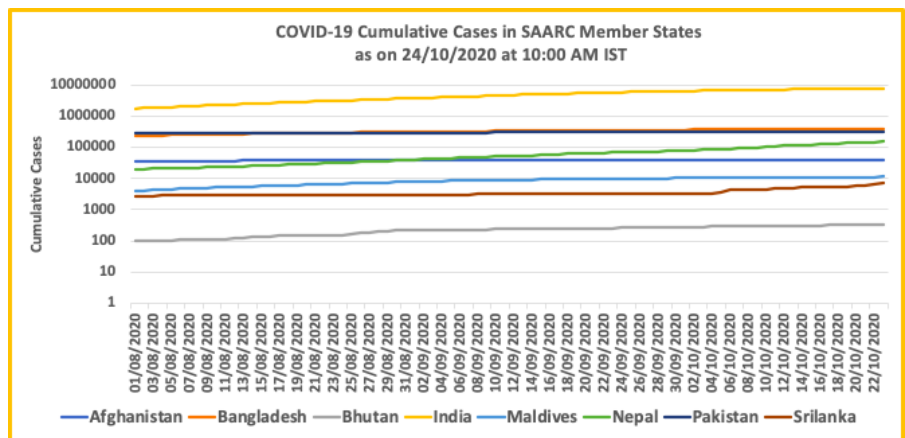
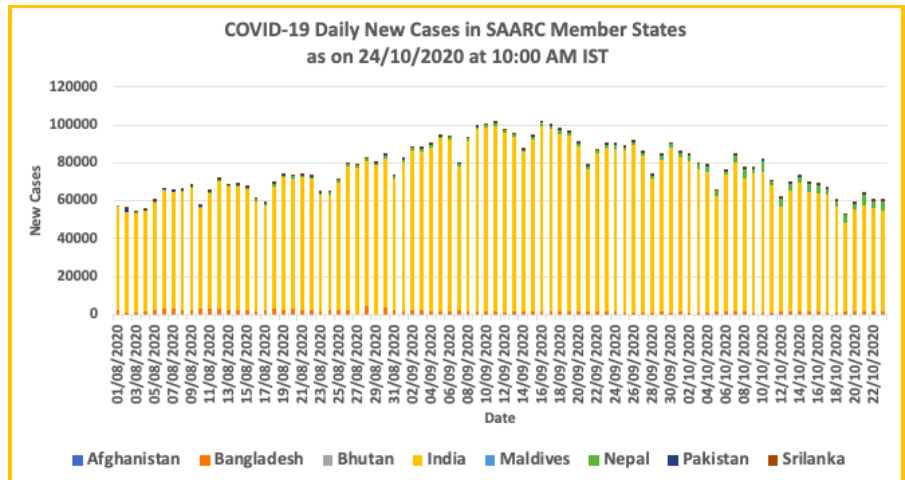

- As of 23rd October 2020- 41,570,883 people have been affected by COVID-19 worldwide. About 1,134,940 lives have been lost. (Source: WHO)
- SAARC region comprises of over 21% of the world's population which remains vulnerable towards COVID-19. The Member States have reported 87,50,733 cases, a total of 1,32,831 deaths in the region, and 77,92,088 recovered cases.
