- As of 25<sup>th</sup> October 2020- 42,512,186 people have been affected by COVID-19 worldwide. About 1,147,301 lives have been lost. (Source: WHO)
- SAARC region comprises of over 21% of the world's population which remains vulnerable towards COVID-19. The Member States have reported 88,56,017 cases, a total of 1,33,969 deaths in the region, and 79,23,759 recovered cases.
