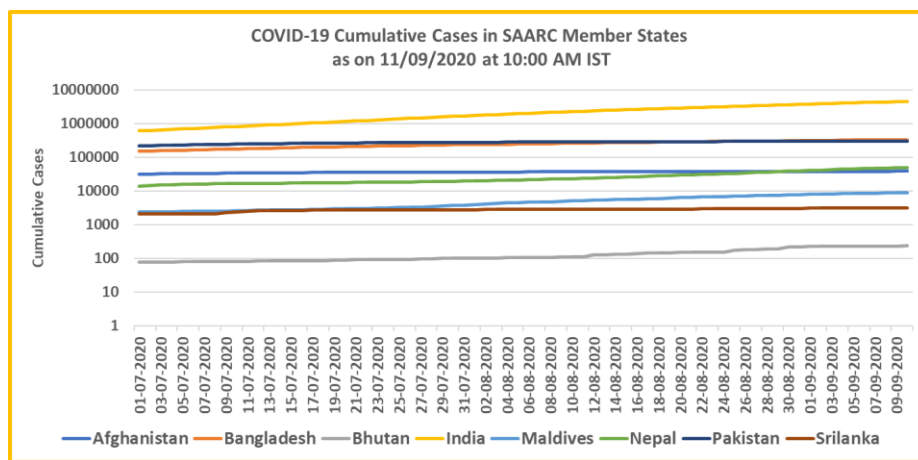
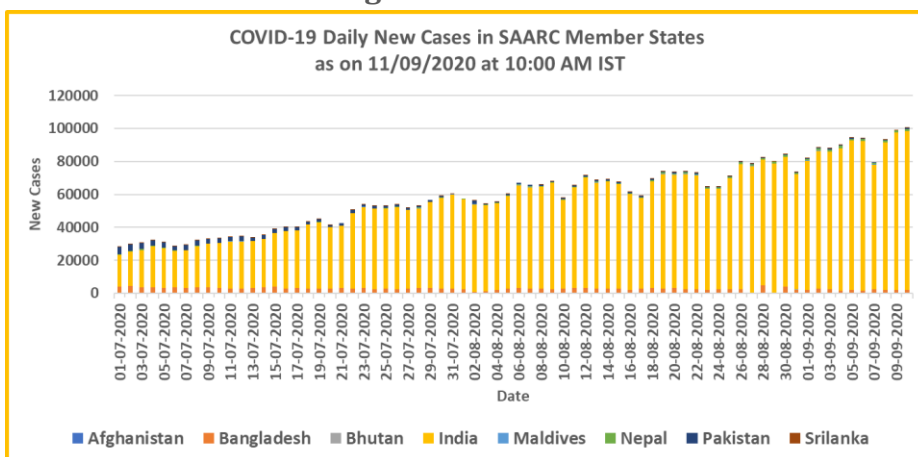

- As of 10<sup>th</sup> September 2020- 27,738,179 people have been affected by COVID-19 worldwide. About 899,916 lives have been lost. (Source: WHO)
- SAARC region comprises of over 21% of the world's population which remains vulnerable towards COVID-19. The Member States have reported 52,97,085 cases, a total of 89,855 deaths in the region, and 41,40,917 recovered cases.
