



- India: Prime Minister announced a Special economic and comprehensive package of Rs 20 lakh Crore - equivalent to 10% of India's GDP on 12th May 2020. He gave a clarion call for Self-Reliant India Movement. On 15th May 2020, the Finance & Corporate Affairs Minister announced the 3rd Tranche of measures to strengthen Infrastructure Logistics, Capacity Building, Governance and Administrative Reforms for Agriculture, Fisheries and Food Processing Sectors. Following measures were announced:
 - Rs 1 lakh crore Agri Infrastructure Fund for farm-gate infrastructure for farmers
 - Rs 10,000 crore scheme for Formalisation of Micro Food Enterprises
 - Rs 20,000 crore for fisherman through Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana
 - National Animal Disease Control Programme
 - Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund - Rs. 15,000 crore
 - Promotion of Herbal Cultivation: Outlay of Rs. 4,000 crore
 - Beekeeping initiatives – Rs 500 crore
 - From 'TOP' to TOTAL – Rs 500 crore
 - Measures for Governance and Administrative Reforms for Agriculture Sector
