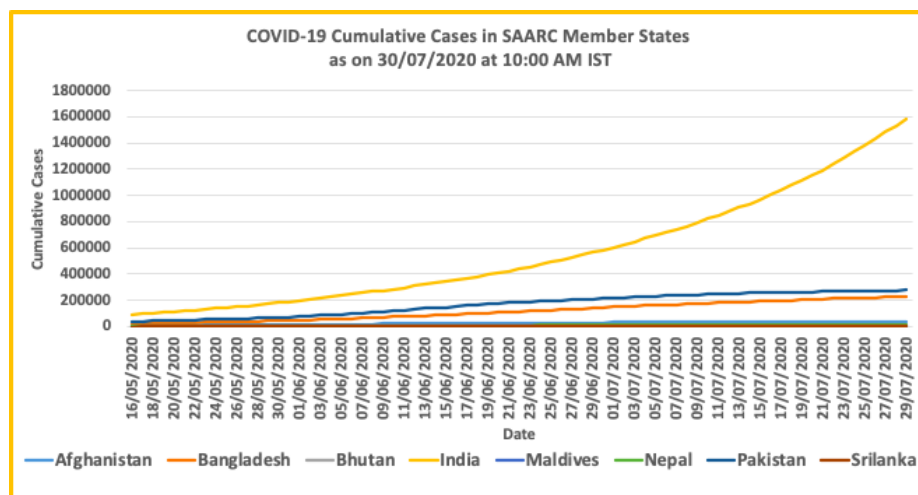
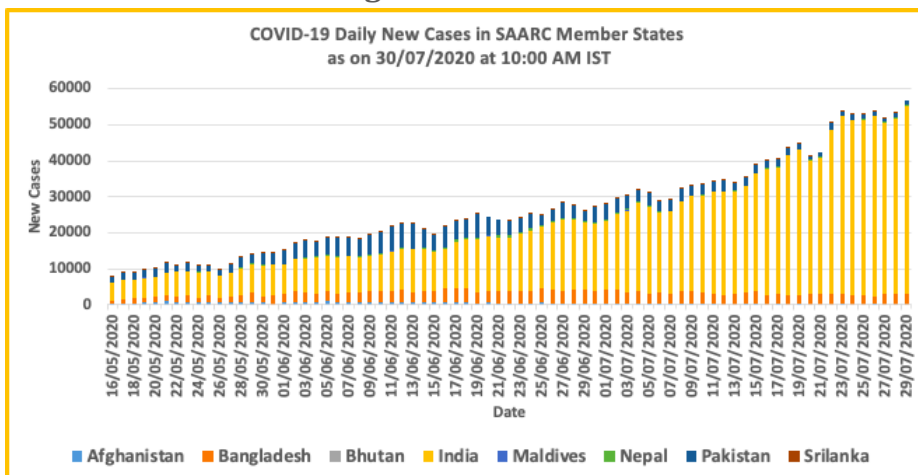

- As of 29th July 2020- 16,558,289 people have been affected by COVID-19 worldwide. About 656,093 lives have been lost. (Source: WHO)
- SAARC region comprises of over 21% of the world's population which remains vulnerable towards COVID-19. The Member States have reported 21,55,611 cases, a total of 45,273 deaths in the region, and 14,41,228 recovered cases.
